Judging - Judging in this department will begin following the 4-H judging on Friday

Regulations:

- Exhibitor must be present to bring rabbit to judge.
- Maximum of 3 entries. Exhibitors cannot enter the same rabbit in more than 1 class.
- Entries will consist of one rabbit
- **Health requirements** - See page 92
- Each exhibitor is responsible for feed, water and feed containers. Shavings are provided.
- All entries must be made in the name of the actual owner, & exhibit must be raised by exhibitor
- No premiums will be paid on disqualified exhibits or exhibits lacking in merit
- Regular judging will be used throughout the Open Class Division (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th)
- The Fair will exercise all reasonable vigilance in the care of exhibits and police arrangements of the building, but all specimens must be entered at the risk of the owner
- **All exhibits are required to register at the Poultry building on Thursday of the fair week from 11 am – 7:30 pm so lot numbers can be checked against pre-registration and all rabbits checked for health**
